With a deep, dark ruby color and rich, full-body, subtle layers of leather, wood, deep cherry, black olive and cassis are unfurled. A smooth tannic backdrop and toasted oak edge nicely accent the flavor profile without enveloping its' excellent fruit qualities.

In 1991 the Kokopelli Winery acquired its grapes from the family owned Bonita Springs Farm located in south eastern Arizona. Our first year of wine production came three years later in 1994, and has grown over the years with locations in Chandler & Surprise Arizona. Kokopelli is the largest winery in the state, and its' award winning wines can be purchased at our Kokopelli Bistros, numerous wine festivals held throughout the year, and at fine retailers throughout Arizona.
