100% Riesling – Cochise County, Az – 2023

Tasting Notes

This dry, orange stye Riesling shows off its heritage with a bright, golden/yellow color. Citrus blossoms and fresh herbs dazzle the nose. On the palate, this crisp and refreshing wine offers up a balanced blend of citrus pith, minerality, and hints of mild tea flavors.

Wine Making Process

Foot stomped
Whole cluster primary fermentation
Secondary Fermentation in barrel
Barrel aged for 14 months in neutral French Oak

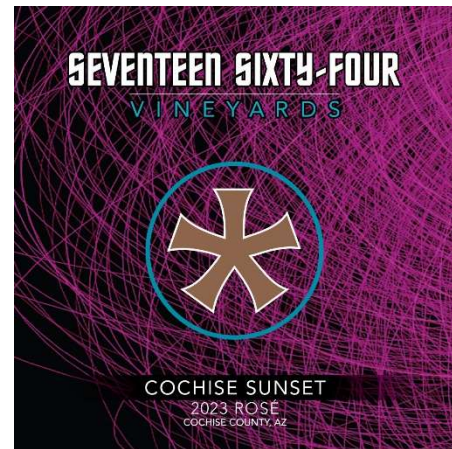
